## Espen Skjerven

Espen Skjerven works as a district court judge at Sør-Rogaland District Court. He has a background as a prosecutor in the national investigative units Økokrim and Kripos, as well as a business lawyer/litigator.

Nothing to Hide is Skjerven's first work of fiction. Skjerven himself experienced losing his hair as a child, and although the story is fictional, it is inspired by his own experiences.



Skjerven has written four books in the crime series about police officer Tom Grayston:

Slaughter (Slakt 2019), Blood is Thicker than Water (Blod er tykkere enn vann, 2021), The Kleptocracy (Kleptokratiet, 2022), and Traitors (Svikere, 2024).

*Traitors* won the Norwegian Silver Dagger Award (Sølvkniven), for best release of 2024.
