Investor Erik Hoff is fighting for his innocence in a brutal double murder case in Sandnes. When police officers Tom Grayston and Dagny Stokka investigate new leads in the case, they become entangled in a dark underworld of prostitution and severe human trafficking. Truth and trust are put to the test, and the line between guilt and innocence is blurred.

Slaughter (Slakt) was published in 2019 by Pitch forlag and is the first in the crime series about Tom Grayston. It is a realistic crime novel containing courtroom drama, police investigation, and sequences of suspense.

This is what Skjerven said about Slaughter:

"As the author of *Slaughter*, I have had the privilege of creating my own story and my own universe, where the main goal has been to provide exciting entertainment. At the same time, I wanted to challenge the genre somewhat: to bring seriousness into the fiction. The reader is given the opportunity to ask themselves the following questions: Could this have happened in reality, and is society doing enough to prevent this type of crime?"

Skjerven has written four books in the crime series about police officer Tom Grayston: *Slaughter* (Slakt 2019), *Blood is Thicker than Water* (Blod er tykkere enn vann, 2021), *The Kleptocracy* (Kleptokratiet, 2022), and *Traitors* (Svikere, 2024).



Traitors won the Norwegian Silver Dagger Award (Sølvkniven), for best release of 2024.
